***Masterton aviation event
Effective: 12 to 19 JAN 09***

The NZ Sport and Vintage Aviation Society will hold the Wings over Wairarapa aviation event at Masterton aerodrome over the period 16 – 18 JAN 09. A temporary restricted area is prescribed to facilitate the safety of air navigation as follows:

NZR 590 Masterton, Wairarapa	
All that airspace bounded by a circle, 5 NM radius, centred on S 40 58 24.0, E 175 38 01.0 (Masterton aerodrome reference point).	
Upper limit:	9500ft AMSL.
Lower limit:	Surface.
Activity:	Active between 0901152100 and 0901160400; (1000 and 1700, FRI 16 JAN 09 NZDT); 0901162100 and 0901170400; (1000 and 1700, SAT 17 JAN 09 NZDT); 0901172100 and 0901180400; (1000 and 1700, SUN 18 JAN 09 NZDT); aviation event.

Masterton aerodrome will be closed to all traffic, except authorised airshow participants and emergencies when NZR590 is active.

Arrivals

Aircraft arriving on FRI 16 and SAT 17 JAN 09 should exercise special care, as there will be frequent arrivals and departures and low-level aerobatics practised by vintage and military aircraft during daylight hours. Pilots should listen to the AWIB and report position on frequency 119.1 MHz 10 NM inbound and taxiing for entry approval. Standard circuit procedures must be observed by radio-equipped and NORDO aircraft.

Services

The following services will be provided from 1000 to 1700, FRI 16 JAN 09 and from 0800 to 1800, SAT 17 JAN 09 and SUN 18 JAN 09 NZDT:

1. a base radio call sign "Masterton Radio" (frequency 119.1 MHz); and
2. an AWIB (Aerodrome and Weather Information Broadcast), on frequency 132.8 MHz, activated by four transmissions within four seconds.
3. Display direction (not ATC) on frequency 130.2 0 MHz call sign "Display Director"

for practise and display aircraft.

Air traffic services will **not** be provided during this event. Masterton Radio will not provide traffic information or traffic avoidance advice.

No flight plan facilities will be available at Masterton Base. Pilots should submit flight plans before departure from their home aerodrome.

Fuel management

Pilots should plan for extra fuel reserves, as there could be short delays. Access to the fuel pumps will be available, except during 17 and 18 JAN 09, when Avgas and Jet A1 tanker service will be available.

Pilot briefings

There will be a display briefing for all event participants at 1000 on FRI 16, and 0900 on SAT 17 and SUN 18 JAN 09 NZDT at The Sports and Vintage Aviation Society Museum. Pilots wishing to practice on FRI 16 JAN 09 and the morning of SAT 17 or SUN 18 JAN 09 should contact the Display Director. Early notification is recommended as practise slots will be limited.

Security

Pilots should note that an additional airfield security fence will be in place from MON 12 JAN 09 to MON 19 JAN 09 and will extend from the Wairarapa Aero Club, along grass runway 10/28 to the runway intersection, then northwards parallel to runway 06/24 to the aerodrome boundary fence. The fence will be at least 50 metres clear of the sealed and grass runways. Additional lighting will be available to light the security fence and will be marked for night operations.

Prescribed pursuant to Civil Aviation Rules, Part 71 *Designation and Classification of Airspace*, under a delegated authority issued by the Director of Civil Aviation.
